TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

CATEGORY A Full Membership	Must have membership in the NLTA AND at least one of the following: (i) a Master's or equivalent degree in Professional Counselling or Psychology from a recognized university, OR (ii) possession of Certified Canadian Counsellor status with Canadian Counselling and Psychotherapy Association (CCPA), OR (iii) registration with the Newfoundland Board of Examiners in Psychology.
CATEGORY B Associate Membership	An associate member is one who is interested in the field of counselling and psychology, supports the objectives of the Association, and is granted affiliation without meeting the requirements of full membership. An associate member shall have all privileges and responsibilities of a regular member with the exception of the right to hold office and voting privileges at the AGM.
CATEGORY C Student Membership	Student membership shall be for any person registered in a full-time program of studies leading to a degree in counselling and / or psychology.
CATEGORY D Retired Member	An NLCPA member (e.g. Category A or Category B) who has retired, but wishes to retain membership.
